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CONDITIONS OF SALE - COMBATANT VESSELS

ARTICLE BA: DISPOSITION AND USE OF HAZARDOUS PROPERTY.

Purchasers are warned that articles or substances of a corrosive, reactive, ignitable, toxic or other hazardous nature, i.e., polychlorinated biphenyls, asbestos, etc., not previously identified in the Invitation for Bids may remain on the vessel. The Purchaser represents, warrants, and certifies to the United States Government that he will use or ultimately dispose of any hazardous property or residue resultant from the purchase of Item 1 in accordance with all applicable local, Federal, and international laws and regulations in a manner safe for the public and the environment. The Government assumes no liability for damage to the property of the Purchaser or for personal injuries, disabilities or death to the Purchaser or the Purchaser's employees or to any other person arising from or incident to the purchase of this material or its use or disposition. The Purchaser shall hold the Government harmless from any or all such demands, suits, actions, or claims of whatsoever nature arising from or out of the purchase of this material.

ARTICLE BB: TITLE.

Title to the scrap, parts and/or components available for removal shall vest to the Purchaser as and when said property is physically removed from the vessel or residue thereof.

ARTICLE BC: RISK OF LOSS.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Condition 14, Sale of Government Property - General Sale Terms and Conditions, Part 2, Standard Form 114C, Sale By Reference, August 1989, Purchaser assumes sole responsibility for the security and protection of the property purchased under the contract as of the date of full payment of the contract price and further assumes responsibility for the security of that property and of its equipment.

ARTICLE BD: QUALIFICATION OF BIDDERS.

The Purchaser or proposed subcontractor(s) must possess all necessary permits, licenses and authorization required by federal, state, and/or local laws, and have the capability and facilities to perform the operations required by the contract. The U.S. Government reserves the right to inspect the premises and facilities of any Purchaser or subcontractor to determine whether he has the capability to ensure the security and safety of the property and perform the work as required under the contract.

ARTICLE BE: SUBCONTRACTS.

No subcontracts shall be made by the Purchaser with any other party with respect to any phase of the operations involved in this contract without the prior written approval of the Sales Contracting Officer.

ARTICLE BF: GOVERNMENT MAY ENTER PREMISES.

The Purchaser agrees to cooperate with and to permit all authorized Government representatives to enter the premises of the Purchaser or its subcontractors if any, at all reasonable times for the purpose of inspecting contract performance.

ARTICLE BG: MANIFESTING.

In the event that any item or component remaining on board the vessel for sale as Item 1, whether or not identified in the Invitation for Bids, is subject to EPA Regulations, Purchaser is cautioned that it is solely responsible to ascertain the extent to which these regulations affect it and compliance therewith. However, as a minimum, said item(s) or component(s) must be manifested with a transporter having an EPA identification number. Purchaser must complete all required manifest documents prior to each hazardous waste removal. Copies of the complete manifest must be provided to the generator within the time required by environmental laws and regulations.

ARTICLE BH: STATE REGULATED HAZARDOUS WASTE.

Item(s) or component(s) remaining on board the vessel offered for sale as Item 1, whether or not identified in the Invitation for Bids, may be regulated in the state where the vessel will be berthed during contract performance. Purchaser is solely responsible for ascertaining the extent to which said state regulations affect it and for compliance therewith.

ARTICLE BI: CONTRACT PERFORMANCE.

Purchaser understands and agrees to submit a written request for contract modification to the Sales Contracting Officer prior to effecting any change from that stated on its Statement of Intent, End Use Certificate, and/or Sale of Government Property - Item Bid Page, Sealed Bid, whether occurring before or after the release of the vessel(s) to it. The Purchaser further agrees not to effect such changes without first receiving the written approval of the Sales Contracting Officer.

ARTICLE EA: BID DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS.

- (1) All bids must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the amount of 10% of the total amount bid which must be in the possession of the Contracting Officer by the time set for bid opening. Bid deposits and payments shall be in the form of cash, cashier's check, certified check, traveler's check, bank draft, postal money order, bank money order, U.S. Government check properly endorsed, or any combination thereof, made payable to the Treasurer of the United States. All such deposits and payments must be in U.S. currency or be payable in U.S. dollars to the Treasurer of the United States.
- (2) Deposit Bond-Individual Invitation, Sale of Government Personal Property (Standard Form 150) properly executed, or reference to an approved Deposit Bond-Annual, Sale of Government Personal Property (Standard Form 151) is acceptable in lieu of a bid deposit.
- (3) Any bid which is not timely supported by an acceptable bond or bid deposit in the proper form will be rejected as nonresponsive. Any bond or bid deposit received after bid opening will be considered in the same manner as late bids.

ARTICLE EC: STORAGE CHARGES/LATE REMOVAL CHARGES.

If the Purchaser fails to remove the vessel(s) within the time limit specified for removal, or within any extension of time which may have been granted by the Contracting Officer pursuant to Condition No. 8, General Sale Terms and Conditions (Standard Form 114C), charges for wharfage, moorage, dockage, anchorage, berthing or other services will be assessed at the following rates per day per vessel including Saturdays, Sundays and Federal holidays:

In all instances where storage charges are assessed, payment thereof must be made by the Purchaser prior to the removal of the property unless otherwise authorized by the Government. In no event, however, will charges for late removal exceed 10% of the contract price of the vessel as to which the delay occurred.
